Africa Mission 2012

Teams are being assembled, pastors trained and plans made for the 2012 mission to Ghana and Nigeria. Currently, pastors are participating in a three-month training and have begun work in each village visiting house-to-house, conducting Bible studies, praying for the sick and promoting our evangelistic crusades in February.

Christian World Missions' leadership will depart for Ghana on February 8th where they will spend three days visiting churches previously planted. This is part of the process of "...establishing fruit that remains." We want to see first hand how the existing churches are growing and what needs they may have.

The US missionary team will depart for Ghana on February 11 and Nigeria on February 19. Individuals can choose to go to one country or to work in both Ghana and Nigeria. When the team arrives, they join a large contingent of indigenous volunteers (preachers, nurses, doctors, prayer warriors, construction workers) and are deployed into the villages. During the day, the teams offer free medical clinics and begin construction on pavilion churches. In the evenings, evangelistic meetings are conducted, which include music, preaching, testimonies, the Jesus Film and prayer ministry.

The new churches are usually consecrated before our departure and begin meeting together immediately. Sponsors from the U.S. support them through Christian World Missions for the first three years, providing the pastor's salary, a bicycle and Bible, and funds for their first meeting facility. Our African evangelists make regular visits to all of the churches to instruct and encourage.

Time is running out to plan for the 2012 Mission, but you may want to begin planning for the 2013 mission. It will be around the same time in February.
