

Reason 65: Scores of pavilion churches built in Africa, mud-brick churches built in India, bamboo and nipa huts built in the Philippines.

Reason 66: Refurbished churches and camps in Russia and elsewhere.

Reason 67: Mentored hundreds of young pastors and evangelists.

Reason 68: Hosted hundreds in short-term mission trips, introducing many lay people to their first preaching experience.

Reason 69: Introduced many local churches to the Spirit-filled Life, and a new understanding of Spiritual Gifts.

Reason 70: Introduced many local churches to intentional evangelism, including training in the Four Spiritual Laws, Evangelism Explosion, and other one-on-one evangelism tools.

Reason 71: Launched the ministries of several pastors and evangelists through counsel and financial support.

Reason 72: Provided funding for seminary education for many African Methodist leaders.

Reason 73: Led the Mississippi Conference in the work of evangelism for many years.

Reason 74: Hosted Conferences on the Holy Spirit to help local pastors learn how to incorporate teaching about the 3rd Person of the Trinity into their regular church experience.

Reason 75: Established Video Leadership Ministries and distributed the teachings of many favorite Bible leaders from the 1970's and '80's.

Reason 76: Established Global Health Resources (GHR) and distributed medication and medical equipment to hospitals and clinics worldwide.

Reason 77: Constructed the warehouse for GHR which was later used for collection and distribution of aid during the Hurricane Katrina crisis. It is now The Storehouse at Christian World Missions and is used daily for local outreach to underserved teens and their families, and for retreats and conferences in Christian growth.

Reason 78: Collected and distributed books to establish Bible college and seminary libraries in India and Africa.

Reason 79: As a pastor, regularly hosted Lay Witness Missions and revivals, allowing his congregations and his family to hear the Gospel from other lips, and to hear God's call in their lives.

Reason 80: Provided the opportunity for several young adults to work with him as music, youth, and children's evangelists, including his daughter who is still grateful for the best boss she ever had!

Reason 81: Gave said daughter her first opportunities to sing for the Lord (age 4), teach a Bible study (age 14), and preach (age 23), and encouraged her to carry-on.

Reason 82: Gave said daughter her first experience in international missions – Philippines, 1986.

Reason 83: Gave said daughter the freedom to fail, and taught her to rise up again, full of the power of God.

Reason 84: Drew together a group of counselors to help guide Christian World Missions from 1971 to 2011, and then trusted their guidance to pass the mantle to the next generation.

Reason 85: Mentored said daughter as she assumed the mantle of leadership of CWM, sharing wisdom and insight, helping guide decisions, and continued to help with fund-raising long after his retirement.

Reason 86: Established yet another partnership in Pakistan, even after retirement, carrying on his legacy of evangelism and mentoring.
