Rev. John Zimmerman was raised in the rural community of Stoystown, PA which is just a few miles from the 9/11 terrorist crash site of USAir Flight 93. He heard the call into ministry just after graduation from high school and attended the University of Pittsburgh for



his undergraduate degree and obtained his Master's Degree from Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, DC. Pastor John is nearing 25 years of ministry in local church settings. He has always recognized the spiritual gifts of preaching, healing, and evangelism in his Christian life. God has allowed these gifts to be used in a variety of local church settings which include rural, suburban and city.

His local church leadership is characterized by leading traditional churches into new ministry paradigms that reach the ever-changing community with the never-changing transformational power of Christ through the Holy Spirit. He is currently the senior pastor of the First United Methodist Church in Corry, PA. Following his lead as an adventurous risk-taker, his local church continually discovers the joy of ministry freed from the letter of the law and tradition. Together they are on a journey to rediscover the capital "C" Church and opportunities to make disciples of Christ for the transformation of the world. He is currently working on a project with United Methodist Communications and the "Rethink Church" team in the content development of their soon-to-be released program entitled "Communicate Vitality."

He enjoys hunting, camping and opportunities to enjoy his family. His wife, Christine, holds a K-6 grade teaching certificate and is the reading specialist in the local school district. 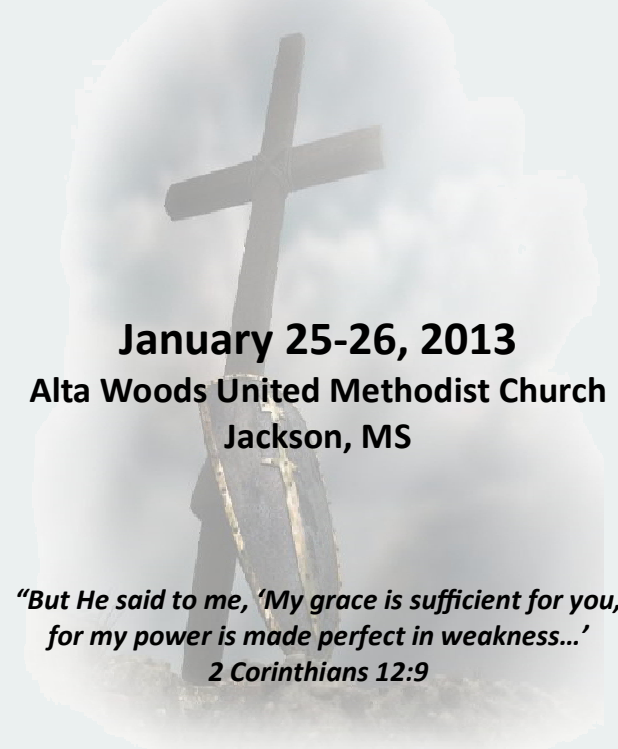
