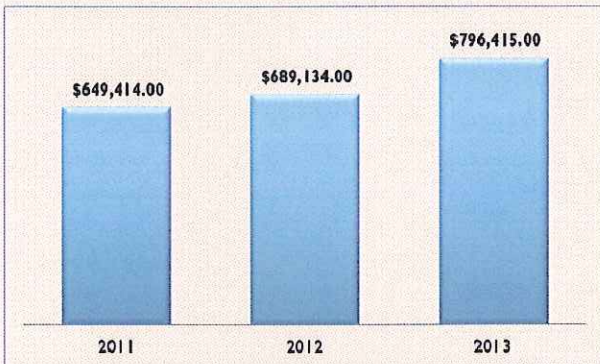

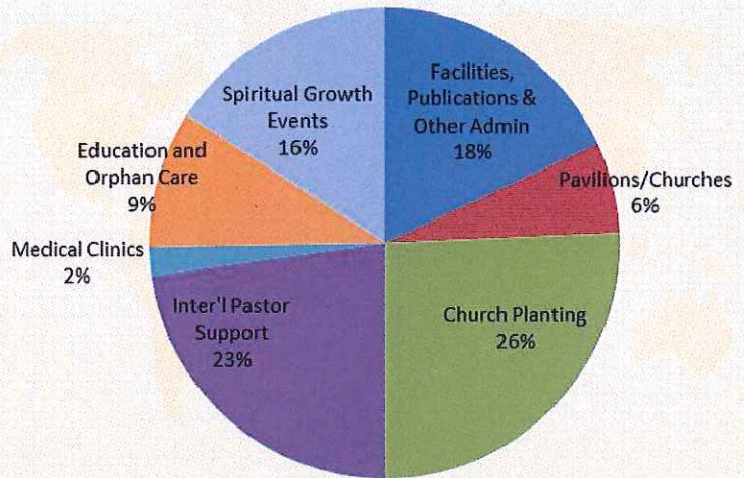

**ANNUAL BUDGET**



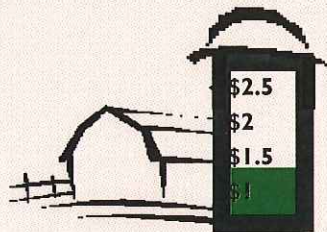

## OPPORTUNITIES

- ♦ We have a 10,000 square foot facility.
- ♦ The largest concentration of lower income people in Starkville surrounds our facility.
- ♦ We are currently developing partnerships with local churches, volunteer groups like Fellowship of Christian Athletes and VISTA.
- ♦ We can model locally what we are doing nationally and internationally.



## CURRENT LOCAL MINISTRIES

- ♦ Worship/Intercession Gatherings
- ♦ Monthly Community Events
  - Movie nights with popcorn (Movies with a Christian message)
  - Remote tailgate (Games, food, testimonies)

## FACILITY/STAFF NEEDS

- ♦ Immediate Requirements:
  - Staff (community liaison) and Volunteers
  - Heating and air conditioning system
  - Additional construction for climate control/storage
  - Other improvements as dictated by Health and Human Services
- ♦ Long-range:
  - Warming kitchen
  - Additional equipment
  - Furnishings

## Financial Needs for Outreach/Worship Center - Phase I

- ♦ Heating and air system, supporting electrical work and construction: \$40,000
- ♦ Additional furnishings: \$10,000

**Making disciples** by coming alongside the local church for Bible studies, training sessions, conferences and retreats

## 2013 Areas of Emphasis

**CARING** through medical clinics, feeding the poor, caring for orphans and widows, teaching life skills

**Witnessing** through evangelistic services, children's ministry, establishing new churches and evangelism in humanitarian outreach

**Making disciples** through pastor training, Bible college, establishing churches, and Bible studies

## India

- ◆ Orphanage—apprx 200 children
- ◆ Primary school—270 students
- ◆ Bible College—94 students (turned away students for lack of space)
- ◆ Sewing school/business
- ◆ Jaya Institute of Paramedical Sciences (Nursing School) - 82 students
- ◆ Churches—1000 with apprx 700 pastors
- ◆ Vacation Bible school—apprx 5000 children (majority from Hindu families)
- ◆ Medical clinics, open daily



## Ghana and Nigeria, Africa

- Apprx 5000 people came to Christ during Africa missions
- Over 400 churches (Plant 10 in each country every year)
- Expanded number of US team members 11 in Ghana, 12 in Nigeria
- Medical clinics in villages where new churches are being planted (Indigenous doctors)
- Pastor training (over 30 pastors trained in 2012)
- Added children's ministry
- Assessment, preparations and recruitment made for 2013 Agricultural program
- Preparatory work done to expand into northern areas
